

## NEGLECTED DEVELOPMENTAL DYSPLASIA OF HIP : A CASE REPORT

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**Introduction:** Developmental dysplasia of hip is where the ball and socket joint of the hip does not properly form and usually was detected early in babies and young children. This a case report of case report of a DDH in a young adult.

**Conclusion:** The treatment of hip dysplasia in young adults remains a challenge. Although advanced surgical technique such as the periacetabular osteotomy and their capacity to preserve the hip and its function for a substantial period is now well established, total hip replacement remains an excellent option for adult DDH.
