

## FLOATING ANKLE IN PAEDIATRIC A CASE REPORT

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**Introduction:** Distal tibia fracture associated with talus fracture over the ipsilateral side are uncommon in the population and even rarer in the paediatric age group. The management of these fracture are not well described in literature. This is a case report for a floating ankle in paediatric.

**Conclusion:** Definitive guidelines regarding treatment and incidence of avascular necrosis following talar fractures in paediatric population has yet to be elucidated. However, awareness of this rare fracture can help early identification of injured children, expedite treatment, followed by clinical and radiological follow-up, assessing for avascular necrosis of the talus.
